RE: Rescinding of Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory

Dear Administration:

This letter is to advise that the Water Security Agency (WSA) in consultation with the Saskatchewan Health Authority – North Battleford has by way of this letter rescinded the Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory (PDWA) issued to **Line 5 which includes residence on 1st Steet West and Main Street between Railway Avenue and 2nd Avenue in the Village of Meota** effective **November 29, 2022**. This advisory has been rescinded after the required samples from the distribution system have returned with acceptable results and the system has been flushed.

I would advise the Village to issue immediate notice to the public of the rescinding of the advisory. Further, the Village may return to its regular sampling intervals. If a positive sample is realized upon immediate return to regular sampling submission, the Water Security Agency may if believed necessary consider the issuance of a new PDWA.
