Areas affected; 1st St. West, Main St. 2nd Ave, 2nd St East, 5 corners, 5th Ave & Lakeview/Beach Ave, Birch St.

To help reduce the potential for back ups/ sewer smell in houses, below are a couple options recommended by the contractor.

- Put a 20 litre pail half full of water on any floor drains, if you could put a garbage bag over the floor drain first that will also help reduce any water from going on the floor.
- Any toilets (basements have the best chance of having issues, but it wouldn't hurt to do the main floor and well, wouldn't worry about the second level) put a garbage bag on first than the seat and some kind of weight, can use anything really just make sure it is no lighter than 5 pounds.
- After the work is completed and if they have a sewer smell, the flushing truck creates large amounts of vacuum which can suck out P-traps out now if the ptraps have no water then sewer gas can pass through and go into the house. The water is what stops the gas from coming in, as long as they run water in floor drains, sinks, bath, tubs as well as make sure the toilet has water in it they should be good. P-traps are very small so a liter or two will be sufficient
