

**VILLAGE OF MEOTA  
BYLAW #8/2014**

**A BYLAW TO PERMIT THE OPERATION OF GOLF CARTS ON THE PUBLIC  
HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF MEOTA.**


The Council of the Village of Meota, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be referred to as the "Golf Cart Bylaw";
2. DEFINITIONS;  
"CAO" – means the Administrator of the Village of Meota;  
"Golf Cart" – means a small three or four wheeled vehicle used for transporting golfers and their equipment around a golf course;  
"Highway" – means any public road in the limits of the Village of Meota;  
"Municipality" – means the Village of Meota;  
"Mayor" – means the Mayor of the Village of Meota;
3. It shall be lawful to operate a golf cart during the hours between one half hour prior to sunrise and one half hour after sunset on all public highways within the limits of the Village of Meota;
4. Persons operating a golf cart on the public highways within the limits of the Village of Meota must be using the golf cart for the purpose of transportation to and from the golf course, by the direct shortest route;
5. Golf Carts shall be allowed on all highways within the Village of Meota limits;
6. No person shall operate a golf cart on the public highways within the limits of the Village of Meota without a valid driver's license, minimum of Class 7;
7. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable, on summary conviction, to a fine of not less than \$100.00 and not more than \$500.00;
8. All personal and public liability will be the responsibility of the owners/operator of the said golf cart. All golf carts operated on a highway are required to have a minimum of \$200,000 third party liability insurance;
9. This bylaw does not apply to the operation of golf carts that are used solely on the Golf Course;
10. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of approval being issued by SGI.
