BYLAW #3/2012

A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF FIREARMS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF MEOTA

The Council of the Village of Meota in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be called “ The Firearms Bylaw”.
2. In this Bylaw:
 - a. “Firearms” shall be deemed to include any class or caliber of firearm, air gun or spring gun.
 - b. “Peace Officer” includes a police officer, police constable, bailiff, constable, or other persons employed for the preservation and maintenance of the public peace.
 - c. “Municipality” shall mean the Village of Meota.
3. No person, unless authorized by this bylaw, shall discharge any firearm within the Municipality.
4. The following persons are authorized to discharge firearms within the Municipality:
 - a. Peace Officers acting in the line of duty.
 - b. An employee of the Village for the purpose of controlling pests.
 - c. A pest control officer appointed by resolution of Council.
 - d. Persons shooting within the confines of a Government approved gun range.
 - e. Persons participating in Council approved sporting events, such as turkey shoots, or similar events, upon such terms and conditions as Council stipulates.
5. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties imposed by the General Penalty Bylaw of the Village of Meota.
6. Bylaw #59, A Bylaw respecting firearms and fireworks, is hereby repealed.
